For the tenured faculty position, we are seeking a candidate with a doctorate in either aerospace or mechanical engineering, administrative experience, and a record of academic accomplishment meriting the tenured appointment. For the tenure-track faculty position in Aerospace engineering, we are seeking an applicant with expertise in the areas of space systems and spacecraft engineering. For the tenure-track faculty position in Mechanical engineering, we are seeking an applicant with expertise in the areas of design and manufacturing. Exceptional candidates in other areas of expertise may be considered. Demonstrated teaching and industrial experience is desirable. For the tenure-track positions, a doctorate in Aerospace/Mechanical Engineering with strong research and teaching skills and publication commensurate with a Ph.D. program is required.

Responsibilities include teaching, research, laboratory development, student advising, and university services. The tenure-track appointments are at the level of Assistant Professor, although appointment at higher levels may be considered for candidates with exceptional qualification and experience. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
